## **Condition scoring of cattle**

#### How to do it:


Feel the amount of fat under the skin in 2 areas:

- A. Loin area between hip bone and last rib
- B. Area around the tail head Use condition scoring to determine if:

- Your cattle are in a satisfactory condition for breeding and production
- Your animals are sick and losing condition

Always **feel** the areas as well as looking at the condition

## Condition is scored from 1 to 5

1 =too thin


4 = fat

**2** = thin, but healthy

5 =much too fat

**3** = ideal condition





- **©** Condition score 3 is the ideal condition
- **Ordition score should not drop below 2**
- **Animals** that are too fat can have problems with breeding and calving

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
