Does running Access for Web affect server performance?						
•						
<ul> <li>Products like Access for Web do not put much strain on the system</li> </ul>						
How does the web application server affect performance?						
• If you have an older, under-powered iSeries, then performance may not be goodif you have a newer, bigger iSeries, then performance won't be an issue (unless you already are running your system at maximum capacity).						
<ul> <li>Use the IBM eServer Workload Estimator to see what performance will be if WAS is added to your system at: http://www-912.ibm.com/wle/EstimatorServlet</li> </ul>						
• There are also workload estimators for WebFacing and HATS. Access for Web will be similar (depending on what functions of Access for Web are being used).
