This shows the basic look of iSeries Access for Web as we ship it. You can try various functions -- including working with printer output, creating database requests, etc. Click on the 5250 tab, sign onto the iSeries, then start an RPG application called BOATS and run it.

This is an example of how a customer might design a web page for their use. You will see that an end user could start the same BOATS application by clicking on the 5250 session, or they could have used HATS to run the application. You will also see other links that would let a user work with spoolfile information, work with IFS, run database requests, etc..



### Change look of 5250 session

- 2. Changed colors, added keypad at side, changed buttons at bottom to words

- 4. Selected 'traditional' view, removed navigation bar




#### **Active Session**

- An active session is a session that has been started
  - Dynamically or configured session
- A user may have more than one active session



#### **Active Session - Web View**



Switch to traditional view by selecting the "Traditional view" link



#### **Active Session - Traditional View**



Switch to web view by selecting the "Web view" link



#### Web View vs. Traditional View

- Web View
  - Proportional font
  - Menu displayed as links
  - Active function keys displayed as buttons
  - Allows cursor positioning at non-input fields
  - Display "More..." as button
  - Message line (25<sup>th</sup> line) treated as help

- Traditional View
  - Fixed width font
  - Function key bar (F1-F24)
  - Background color configurable (default is black)

All the view settings are configurable. Configure web and traditional view settings for your environment.

### **Active Session Settings**

- Changing active session settings does not affect the configured session settings
  - The changes are tied to the running instance of the session
  - Changes only affect how this particular active session behaves
- Some settings are not modifiable
  - Server name
  - Port
  - Code page
  - Workstation ID
  - Default view (web or traditional)
  - Initial macro



### **Active Session Life Span**

- Session resides on the server, not the workstation
- Session remains active until
  - User ends (stops) the session, or
  - Session time out due to inactivity
    - Time out value is configurable through Access for Web
- Closing the browser or turning off the workstation does not end the session
- Taking advantage of active session behavior
  - Leave the session and browse on the web, or
  - Leave your workstation and go to another workstation and
  - Reconnect to your session





### **Configure a New Session**


- New sessions are added to the "Configured sessions" list
- Similar to "Start session" settings
  - Server, port, code page, workstation ID
- Additional settings
  - View and color





### **Configured Session Actions**

- Start
  - Start the configured session
- Copy
  - Make a copy of the configured session for yourself
- Delete
  - Delete the configured session
- Rename
  - Rename the configured session
- Create Shortcut
  - Share the configured session with another user or group of users
- Edit
  - Change the configured session settings






#### **Shortcuts**

- iSeries Access for Web objects are only accessible by users that created them
- Shortcut is a pointer to an iSeries Access for Web object. Examples:
  - Configured 5250 session
  - Database request
- Method used to share object with other users
  - Create shortcut for user or group to share with user or group
- User of the shortcut has read only access to the object
  - Cannot modify or delete the object
  - Can delete the shortcut if the shortcut is created for the user
    - Cannot delete the shortcut if the shortcut is created for a group the user belongs to
- Shortcuts to an object are deleted when the object is deleted









## **Keypads**

- Three sets of keypads
  - Top, right, and bottom
  - Each set can be customized
  - Each set can be turned on or off
- Macros can be assigned to keypad
- Configuration is per user
  - One keypad configuration per user
  - Global across all session configurations
  - Not tied to session configuration





#### **Macros**

- Behaves differently than PC5250
  - Keys processed on a screen by screen basis
    - PC5250 every key is recorded and played back
    - iSeries Access for Web cursor positioned in field and keys entered into field
  - On a given screen, keys may not be processed in the same order as they are entered
  - Functionally equivalent, but behaves differently


## Single Sign-on with Macro

- Create a macro to login to 5250
  - Using your own user ID and password
- Edit the macro and replace your user ID and password with directives to use the user's login
- Share the macro (create shortcut) with the user or group
- Associate the macro with a session so the macro is executed when the session starts
- Share the session (create shortcut) with the user or group

NOTE: Sign-on macro is useful for V5R3 iSeries Access for Web. V5R4 iSeries Access for Web has a Bypass Sign-on option; therefore, sign-on macro not needed.





#### **Session Defaults**

- Default values are used to
  - Start a session dynamically
  - Configure a new session
- Two ways to set defaults
  - User can set the default values
    - Default values only apply to the user
  - Use a configured session as default (policy)
    - May be set for user or group


#### **Notes: Shared Sessions**







## Things to know

Because iSeries Access for Web 5250 is implemented using HTML and is servlet based, there are considerations to be aware of. This 5250 interface...

- is not a full-function emulator
  - does not have keyboard interaction and keyboard mapping capability of full-function E.g., 'field exit' cannot be done with one keystroke.
- is not intended to replace full-function emulators like PC5250, PCOMM, Host On-Demand, etc. for purposes of "heads-down" data entry type of operations
- does not include file transfer from session
- does not include printer emulation
  - i5/OS strategy is Internet Printing Protocol (IPP) printing
  - iSeries Access for Web provides capability to convert spooled files to PDF
- does not include graphics, EHLAPPI, DDE functionality
- does not have direction interaction with server, so unsolicated server messages can't be received. (The user needs to request refresh or take an action on the interface to see break messages)
