User ID = WUSER Password = DEMO2PWD	This shows the basic look of Access for Web as we ship it. You can try various functions including working with printer output, creating database requests, etc. Click on the 5250 tab, sign onto i5/OS, then start an RPG application called BOATS and run it.
User ID = BOATADMIN Password = DEMO2PWD	This is an example of how a customer might design a web page for their use. You will see that an end user could start the same BOATS application by clicking on the 5250 session or they could have used WebFacing to run the application. You will also see other links that would let a user work with spoolfile information, work with IFS, run database requests, etc

## **System i Access for Web Overview**

System i Access for Web is software that runs on i5/OS. It provides access to various i5/OS resources through a browser and provides a user-centric, web-based view of i5/OS applications and information. No software is required to be installed on the workstation, other than a web browser.

System i Access for Web functions include:


- *Print* printer output viewing, printers, shared printers, and output queues
- *Messages* user messages, message queues, send messages
- Jobs work with jobs and server jobs
- 5250 user interface
- Database run SQL statements, work with tables, upload data, manage frequently run requests, extract server object information
- *Files* work with files in the i5/OS integrated file system or within NetServer file shares, upload files to the integrated file system or a NetServer share.
- Command run iSeries commands from the browser.
- *Download* manage file/software distribution
- **Customize** configure settings and restrict usage of the functions of the product.



## How to build a home page to i5/OS

- A default HTML home page is displayed when the iWAHome servlet is invoked.
  - http://<mySystem.myCompany.com>/webaccess/iWAHome
  - It's a starting point to highlight functions.
  - It's an example of how to build your own home page or pages that access System i Access for Web functionality.
- A default HTML template is used to display functional pages of System i Access for Web
- To build a home page to i5/OS...
  - Override the default home page HTML
  - Override the default template HTML
  - Override the default CSS
  - For a specific user, group of users, or all users of the i5/OS system
  - Use the System i Access for Web Customization interface to override

## **Template file customization**

- System i Access for Web has a default look for it functional pages.
  - This look is controlled by a template file and cascading style sheet.
- The template file has sections to specify
  - Header/footer areas of functional pages.
  - Where System i Access for Web content is placed in the page.

• Default template file replacement can be done for all users (\*PUBLIC), or can be changed only for certain users and/or groups of users.



## **Special tags**

- Within the home page and template .html files, special tags are used.
  - When these tags are encountered by the System i Access for Web code, they are replaced with the appropriate content.

  - Allow/Deny/Show/Hide the navigation bar
  - Display images vs. text links
  - Default rows per page







## Why build a home page to i5/OS


- Allows you to provide an integrated look/feel for your company
  - Internal
  - External
- Controls how your users access your i5/OS system(s)
- Controls what i5/OS resources your users access
- Allows you to group user access by the type of user and/or their job category
  - Providing unique look and feel vs. other users/groups of users
  - Taylor what functions are presented to a specific user/group of users
  - Predefine view to i5/OS resource so end users don't have to learn new interfaces when all they want is the data



### The formula for building a homepage to your i5/OS

- 1. Create a Home web page (an HTML document)
- 2. Setup System i Access for Web functions
- 3. Configure System i Access for Web homepage
- 4. Create/configure System i Access for Web template (an HTML document)

## Create a Home web page

- We are going to use Microsoft Word to create a web page (HTML document)
  - Header image, three columns, internal/external links



### • Specifics

- Targeting user profile "THE\_BOSS" as the user of the web page
- Use tables to define where content is placed
- Content = text, hyperlinks, images, etc.
- Save the web page as "filtered" HTML = boat.htm


### **Setup System i Access for Web functions**

- Define System i Access for Web functions...tasks available from the web page
  - Query database inventory, results as HTML to browser
  - Setup access to invoices, spool file as PDF
  - i5/OS command line, use browser credentials
- Give THE\_BOSS user profile access to the actions above
- Setup hyperlinks on the home web page

## **Configure System i Access for Web home page**

- We are going to use Microsoft Word to create a home page (HTML document)
  - Header image, columns, multimeda, internal/external links
- Copy web page and associated files to i5/OS integrated file system
  - Use System i Access for Web Browse files
  - Create directory for HTML source file and images
  - Copy files from workstation to i5/OS
- Grant web app. server user profile authority to the directories/files
  - WebSphere App Server QEJBSVR \*RX
  - ASF Tomcat QTMHTTP \*RX
- Configure System i Access for Web to use web page files
  - Set policy for user THE\_BOSS to use the new Home web page
  - Policies -> General -> Home page HTML file = /boatdemo/boat.htm
  - Open new browser to <u>http://<sys\_name>:<port>/webaccess/iWAHome</u>
    - User = THE\_BOSS

### **Create/configure iSeries Access for Web template**

- We are going to use Microsoft Word to create a web page template (HTML document)
  - Header image, content area, link back to Home page
- Specifics
  - Targeting user profile "THE\_BOSS" as the user of the web page template
  - Use a table to define where System i Access for Web content is placed
  - Special Tags
    - Content placed where special tag %%CONTENT%% is place.
    - Content formatted based on the default System i Access for Web cascading style sheet using special tag %%STYLESHEET%%
    - When these tags are encountered by the iSeries Access for Web code, they are replaced with the appropriate content
  - Save the web page as "filtered" HTML = boat\_template.htm
