*This guide gets you started with a typical installation for DB2 Personal Edition, Version 9.7.*

#### Product Overview

DB2 Personal Edition is a single-user, full-function relational database, ideal for desktop or laptop-based deployments.

#### 4 Step 4: Install DB2 Personal Edition



1. Ensure that the target computers meet the prerequisites described in Step 2.
2. Launch the install wizard using the instructions provided in *Getting Started with DB2 Installation and Administration on Linux and Windows*

#### 5 Step 5: Read the license terms



Make sure that you understand and agree to the license conditions on the Quick Start and Activation CD before you register the license key. The license terms are located on the Quick Start and Activation CDs in the `/db2/license/Windows` directory on Windows operating systems or the `/db2/license/UNIX` directory on the Linux and UNIX operating systems.

## 6 Step 6: Register the license key



You can register the license key by using the **db2licm** command or from the License Center (on Windows and Linux operating systems only).

- To register the license key, enter the **db2licm** command from the command line:

### Windows operating systems

```
db2licm -a x:\db2\license\<license_filename.lic>
```

where x: represents the CD drive that contains the DB2 product Quick Start and Activation CD and <license\_filename.lic> represents the name of the license key file.

### Linux or UNIX operating systems

```
db2licm -a /cdrom/db2/license/<license_filename.lic>
```

where <license\_filename.lic> represents the name of the license key file for the product.

- To register the license key from the License Center:
  1. Start the DB2 Control Center, and select **License Center** from the **Tools** menu
  2. Select the system and installed product for which you are registering a license
  3. Select **Add** from the **License** menu
  4. In the Add License window, select the directory containing the license file
  5. Select the license file, and click **OK**

## 7 Step 7: Install the documentation



You can install the DB2 solution documentation on any Windows or Linux computer in your environment.
