## **WDI Client Security**

- Optional Role Based Access Control
  - Restricts what object types a user can view
  - Restricts what functions a user can perform
  - System specific
  - Supported in the Configuration database
- Use System Editor or Configuration database options to enable or disable
- Applies to all users of the System



## WDI Client Security (continued)

- Optional Access Group support
  - Restricts which specific objects a user can see in list windows
  - System specific
  - Not available in the Configuration database
- Use System Editor to enable or disable
- Applies to all users of the System



#### **Audit Trail**

- Optional Audit Trail support
  - Documents change events
    - Does not document the changes themselves
  - System specific
  - Supported in the Configuration database
- Use System Editor or Configuration database options to enable or disable
- Applies to all users of the System



#### **List Window Enhancements**

- Right click popup menu
- Sort by clicking on a column header
- Reorder columns by dragging column headers
- Show and hide columns by right clicking on a column header
- Folder column
- Tree view
  - Updates for GUI compliance
  - Selected objects can group into "folders"
  - Also supports the right click popup menu



#### **Preferences**

- Preferences used to contain
  - Global options related to Systems
  - Options specific to the current System
  - User options
- System options moved to the System Editor
- User can still set user specific preferences
  - In System Editor
  - In Preferences



## **Configuration Database Options**

- New menu items supporting the Configuration database
- Easier to implement "shared Configuration database"
- Audit Trail
- Security
  - Role Based Access Control
  - No support for Access Groups



## System Editor

- Global System options
- User specific options
- Audit Trail
- Security
  - Role Based Access Control
  - Access Groups



#### **Document Store**

- Formally called the "Transaction Store"
- Includes the existing "Transaction Store" objects
- Now includes XML and Data Format documents
- Existing WDI Server functions...
  - Moved to WDI Client
  - Includes list window to view results
- "Document Store" disabled on default WDI Client Database



## Submitting Work to WDI Server

- The WDI Client can submit work to WDI Server
  - Document Store
  - Service Profiles
  - "Server Command" objects
- Disabled when using any WDI Client supplied database



#### Viewing Results of Submitted Jobs

#### Viewing Results

- List window in the Commands Functional Area
- List window in the Document Store Functional Area
- In the Service Profile Editor
- Will not see the list windows in any WDI Client supplied database



## **Functional Area Changes**

- Setup Functional Area divided into:
  - Adapters
  - Environment
  - Processing
  - Envelope Profiles
- Server Commands Functional Area
- Mapping Functional Area
  - Code Lists included here and in EDI Standards



## Adapters Functional Area

- Mailbox Profile
- Network Profile
- Network Commands Profiles
- Network Security Profile
- Queue Profiles
  - Renamed from MQSeries Queue Profile
- Continuous Receive Profile
  - New fields for common error handling



#### **Environment Profiles**

- Application Defaults Profile
  - New fields for common error handling
  - New tab pages "Error Handling", "Associated Error Messages" – for common error handling
- Language Profile
- CICS Performance profile



## **Processing Functional Area**

- Service Profile
  - Restructured
  - File references replaced by Data References
  - Can be submitted to WDI Server for processing
- MCD Profile
- User Exits
- Event Destination
  - Part of common error handling
- Data References
  - Identifies a logical file used by WDI Server



#### **Envelope Profiles Functional Area**

- Envelope Profiles moved here
- All Envelope Profile Editors have been redesigned
  - Include newer EDI standard envelope fields
  - More information about each field
  - Named according to the EDI Standard
  - Includes only fields that WDI Server will use a value from



#### **Commands Functional Area**

- Command Dictionary
  - Used to group Commands
- Command objects
  - Contains a PERFORM command
  - Identifies Data References used to process the command
- Submissions
  - Used to view results from submitted Command objects, Service Profiles, Document Store items



#### Other Enhancements

- Send and Receive Map Editors
  - Updated tree controls
  - "Find" function
  - Resizable window panes
- Import window
  - Breaks out specific objects
- Object Properties
  - Collects Folder name and/or Access Group
- System Open and Close



## Other Enhancements (continued)

- EDI Standards
  - New field HIPAA Usage
  - Notes moved into parent editors
- New attributes on SetElementAttribute()
- New mapping commands
  - ErrorContext()
  - FAErrorPath()
- Data Format Record ID
  - Now allows multiple fields to be used for a record ID



## Summary

- Improved security options
  - Role Based Access Control, Access Groups, Audit Trail
- Improvements in usability
  - List window, preferences, Systems, functional areas, new WDI Server functions supported by WDI Client
- Increased Document Store function
  - Data Formats, XML Documents, Submitting
- Interaction with the WDI Server
  - Commands, Service Profiles, Document Store
