Maintenance Updates in Version 3.5.00

The following table lists the issues resolved for Connect:Direct OS/400 version 3.5.00. Connect:Direct version 3.5.00 contains all maintenance fixes that were applied to previous versions of Connect:Direct.

1060948	CDLOG and statistics CDSELSTAT command shows compression of 0 although compression was performed.
1064568	Permanent Session Manager jobs are not being restarted after a MCH3402 error is encountered in a Session Manager.
1064585	Connect:Direct does not end with a ENDCD command.
1067346	When SNODENVIRN is equal to OS390, CDRUNJOB results in the error message, CPF0804.
1067778	PMGR is looping at start up if session limits are exceeded.
1067878	Unable to delete submitted Processes using a CL command.
1077343	The WRKSPLMONE command results in the error message, CEE9901.
1085503	MBCS002E-Function iconv failed. Argument list was too long.
1086933	An inbound transfer fails with AIPC045I error when TCP/IP buffers are set larger than 64K and the remote node sends an RU size greater then 64K.
1088768	Some user spaces are not being deleted after normal transfer.
1098821	CDE0301 error is being issued at the same time the CDLOG shows the copy step completed.

1099141	When an invalid value for COMPRESS is entered in a CDRCV command, the following message appears: Text not available for message CDK0142 file CDMSGF.
1124733	A RUNJOB to an OS/400 node is being submitted twice because a dropped socket occurs when trying to send a positive response back to a remote node.
1127083	RUNJOBs are going into the Hold queue because user profile JOBD is set to HOLD(*YES) and RUNJOB now uses JOBD(*USRPRF) instead of JOBD(CDJOBD).
1140143	If Connect:Direct is not shut down every 24 hours, the license key is checked and causes an MCH0601 error resulting in CDPGMR ending and recovering itself.
1140176	Network map entry only allows up to 65000 instead of 65535 for the transmission buffer size.
1169867	WRKCDPARM does not change the local node name in the data area, if the local node name is changed.
1182739	Using an invalid IFS name in FDSN causes MCH0601 and MCH3601 errors.
1183195	A Connect:Direct UNIX node sends a Process with no name causing a MCH3601 error.
1184807	A Connect:Direct OS/390 node sends a FMH with no OUID on a DMBATCH when security is not se up and no stage-1 security exit causing a MCH3601 error.
1185435	CHKOBJ fails on USRSPC after a failed Process CPF0001.
1190264	Requests a look up capability on Connect:Direct commands on the SNODE.
1203788	CDSND using SNDFFD(*YES) fails with a MCH3601 error.
1205968	CDSND using SNDFFD(*YES) fails with AFLH088I if a file is empty because of limits with a _Riofbk() function.
1228084	Using TEXTFILE(*YES) not writing CRLF in ASCII format. Using 0D25 instead of 0D0A.
1232200	Invalid Output queue in CDSPLMON causes a job to abend.
1236321	CDTRACE spool files only show hh:mm:ss on traces.
1236472	Permanent Session Manager job getting MCH3402 error.
1245382	Continual display of message, APSM007E, not necessary as users understand that they are not licensed.
1246270	A TCP/IP timeout on a CDRUNTASK results because RUNTASK Max Time to Wait (RUNTASKTIM) is not being honored over TCP Max Time to Wait (TCPTIMEOUT).
1248876	Perm Session Manager issues the wrong message if trying to issue COPY to an invalid network map after a previous error.
1251058	Inbound transfers to a Connect:Direct OS/400 node get an error message MCH3402 at the end of the job.
