Description

When a proposal is generated multiple times after making changes to the same quote, the generated PDF does not reflect the changes made to the Quote and renders the PDF file from the cache depending on the browser settings.

Solution: The issue has been fixed to work irrespective of the browser cache settings. The PDF is fetched from the server instead of using the browser cache by keeping the URL unique and thus reflecting the changes made to the quote in the generated PDF.

displayed while loading the page.

Solution: While loading the page, the user will see a blank screen for some

time and later the message, "Loading..Please Wait" is displayed.

Known Issue: Whenever an error is encountered, the message

"Loading..Please Wait" is permanently displayed at the top of the screen.

must be run before building the WAR/EAR file.
