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Single sign-on for IBM Emptoris Applications

Users can now access the Emptoris Sourcing application using the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management platform. Emptoris Strategic Supply Management is a suite comprising the following applications:

- IBM Emptoris Contract Management
- IBM Emptoris Program Management
- IBM Emptoris Spend Analysis
- IBM Emptoris Supplier Lifecycle Management
- IBM Emptoris Sourcing

Users can log on, using a single user account and access all applications that are integrated with the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management from the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management header bar. Users need the required permissions to access the applications.

Emptoris Strategic Supply Management

Besides providing a single sign on to all the applications, the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management platform also provides the following features for all products integrating:

- User Management
- Organization Management
- Category and Location Management
- Supplier Management

User Management

Using the user management feature you can create internal and external users and contacts, assign user roles, user groups, and permissions, and enable users for applications. You can activate and suspend users.

You can also create user groups for specific applications in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Organization Management

Using the Organization Management feature, you can create internal organizations with hierarchies. Only internal users can be associated with internal organizations.

Internal organizations created in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management are mapped to organizations in various applications.

You can also import organizations through the batch upload functionality in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Category and Location Management

You can create and manage categories and locations in the Emptoris Virtual Supply Master module of the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

The categories are mastered and published to various applications. In Emptoris Virtual Supply Master, data stewards and category administrators can create, update, and discontinue categories.

Supplier Management

You can manage suppliers using the IBM Emptoris Virtual Supply Master module within Emptoris Strategic Supply Management Platform. Emptoris Virtual Supply Master is the master repository for suppliers, categories, and regions.

Limited Support for Web Services

The Emptoris Strategic Supply Management provides a very limited support for web services. Customers must consult their implementation teams for using the Emptoris

Strategic Supply Management web services.

Functionality moved from Emptoris Sourcing to Emptoris Strategic Supply Management

The following functionalities can now be performed in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management and can not be performed in Emptoris Sourcing:

- Creating and managing buyer organization
- Creating and managing business unit
- Creating and managing supplier organization
- Creating and managing internal and external user
- User preference settings
- Creating and managing category
- Password policy
- Notifications related to, organization, user, and user preferences

Organization

Buyer Organization

Buyer organizations are now created in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management as internal organizations, with details such as, name, code, and URL. Once created, the fields - Organization Name, Organization Code, and URL is synched to Emptoris Sourcing. The organization is further configured in Emptoris Sourcing with settings like currencies and so on.

The organization has to be activated in Emptoris Sourcing for use.

Business Unit

Business units are now created in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. All child organizations of Emptoris Strategic Supply Management are mapped as business units in Emptoris Sourcing.

Supplier Organization

Supplier organizations are now created and mastered in the Virtual Supply Master of Emptoris Strategic Supply Management as external organizations and then synched to Emptoris Sourcing. Supplier organizations can now be created with duplicate names.

Supplier profiles now have system fields referred to as Golden Attributes which are configured and updated in Virtual Supply Master of Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Suppliers can make changes to the user defined profile attributes of their own organization. To do so the option - "Allow Maintenance by supplier" has to be enabled.

Categories

Categories are now created and mastered in Virtual Supply Master of Emptoris Strategic Supply Management and synched to Emptoris Sourcing.

Category Information Attributes

Category Information attribute creation, item creation, and attachment upload, is performed and managed in Emptoris Sourcing.

Category Integration Framework now only supports creating new information attributes and updating values for these information attributes.

Category Re-parenting

You can now re-parent categories in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. In re-parenting, the category selected, and all child categories and items underneath can be moved and placed anywhere in the category hierarchy. Historical events and items from category do not get impacted. The change applies only to new events.

Users

Buyer and Supplier users are now created in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. For a user to be available in Emptoris Sourcing, the user has to be explicitly assigned to Emptoris Sourcing.

All user preferences such as role assignment, default landing page, business unit linking, category linking, preferred language, currency and so on is now set in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

User Roles

Roles are assigned to users in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. User permissions related to management of users, categories, organizations, and suppliers are assigned in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Password Policy

Password policy is now set in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management and is no longer controlled by Emptoris Sourcing.

Supplier Self Registration

Supplier Self Registration can now be done from Emptoris Supplier Lifecycle Management, if the Supplier Qualification is enabled in Emptoris Supplier Lifecycle Management.

User-defined Information Attributes

The following user-defined information attributes are now no longer available in Emptoris Sourcing:

- Buyer Organization Information attributes
- User Information attributes

Navigation

You can now navigate to products that you have access to from the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management header bar.

You can also navigate to products that are integrated with Emptoris Sourcing, by clicking the respective product fields available on the Emptoris Sourcing user interface.

Module Visibility

You can now assign individual modules to users. This can be done in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

PDF Font

Porting of unicode font is no longer supported. Users have to download a new font pack to view PDF contents.

PDF reports are now displayed in HELVETICA font which is the default font and provided by PDF reader.

Terminology Change

The following terms applicable for organizations, users, categories, and items have changed:

- Approve to Active
- Unapprove to Inactive

Integration

Emptoris Sourcing can now be additionally integrated with the following products:

- Emptoris Program Management
- Emptoris Supplier Lifecycle Management

Integration with Emptoris Contract Management

The Supplier Master ID is used for Emptoris Sourcing and Emptoris Contract Management integration. The ExternalID is no longer required for integration.

Contracts creation

The following conditions govern the contract creation:

- Contract creation is supported only if the supplier has been mastered in Virtual Supply Master.
- While creating contracts, if multiple suppliers have the same Master ID, then the contract is created for the supplier that is marked as 'Primary' in Emptoris Contract Management.

Integration with Emptoris Spend Analysis

- The Category Master ID and Supplier Master ID is now used for Emptoris Sourcing and Emptoris Spend Analysis integration. The Spend Node ID and Spend Analyser ID is no longer required..

User Preferences

Language

Emptoris Sourcing supports fourteen languages whereas Emptoris Strategic Supply Management supports nine languages. For languages that are additionally supported by Emptoris Sourcing, the users can be assigned their language preference for the Emptoris Sourcing application from the user page of Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Date Format

Emptoris Strategic Supply Management supports six date formats out of which Emptoris Sourcing supports only three. If a attribute is assigned a date format that is not supported in Emptoris Sourcing, then the date format defaults to - MM/DD/YYYY.

Date formats supported by Emptoris Sourcing are the following:

- MM/DD/YYYY
- DD/MM/YYYY
- YYYY/MM/DD

Date formats supported by Emptoris Strategic Supply Management are the following:

- MM/DD/YYYY
- DD/MM/YYYY

- MM-DD-YYYY

- YYYY-MM-DD

Number Format

Emptoris Strategic Supply Management supports four number formats out of which Emptoris Sourcing supports only three.

If a attribute is assigned a number format that is not supported in Emptoris Sourcing, then the number format defaults to - #,###.##.

Number formats supported by Emptoris Sourcing are the following:

- # ###,##
- #,###.##
- #.###,##

Number formats supported by Emptoris Strategic Supply Management are the following:

- # ###,##

- #,###.##
- #.###,##
- # ###.##

Time Zone

Emptoris Sourcing follows the GMT convention, whereas Emptoris Strategic Supply Management follows UTC convention. When user views date or time information in Emptoris Sourcing, the information will be converted from UTC to GMT.

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Resolved Issues 10.0.0.1

Auction	8.0.1, 9.0.2.1, 9.0.3	ESP-50158 / 235521	In an auction, when some suppliers are invited at lot level and some are invited at item level of the same lot, then the suppliers who are invited at item level are revoked from the event. This happens when supplier invitation starts at item level and then moves to lot level.
Buyer Survey	8.0.2.14	ESP-50602 / 239751	Non-registered users are able to submit buyer survey responses by clicking the 'Previous' button.
Buyer Survey	8.0.2.14	ESP-50603 / 239752	The survey response window of a buyer survey displays the 'Save and Next' and 'Cancel' button as plain text with garbled characters when non registered users are responding to the survey.

Integration		ESP-51019 / 243542	Authored contract creation fails if the event has user- defined formula bid field and a spacer row item definition field and the contract line definition do not contain these fields. This happens when the order of data definition header list and data list is not same.
Notice	9.0.1	ESP-49791 / 00230526	Users receive salutation error while creating Contract Award Notice.
Notification	8.0.2, 9.0.0.1, 9.0.2	ESP-49531 / 225588, 227689	Supplier users with different locales, that is different preferred language, preferred currency, preferred date, preferred number format do not receive messages with attachments. This happens when messages are sent to 'All Bidders' or multiple suppliers.
Notification	9.0.2.2.1	ESP-50394 / 00236487	If the character quote ' is used in the subject and content of a notification, then html entities(') are displayed in instead of the quote.
Notification	9.0.2.2.1	ESP-50394 / 00236487	If the character quote ' is used in the subject and content of a notification, then html entities (') are displayed instead of the quote.
RFx	9.0.2.1.1	ESP-49814 / 232120, 00232635	Users receive salutation error while creating RFx from templates.
RFx	9.5.0.1	ESP-50643 / 00235871	Users receive salutation error while creating approval forms, if event server is included in the installation.
Scenario	8.0.3.17	ESP-50179 / 235109	Scenarios that have scope set to lot and item level do not complete successfully.

Function	Found in Version	Tracking Number/Sales Force Number	Description
Emptoris Strategic Supply Management		CFGS-1458	Installing applications from a previously saved configuration is not supported for this release. If you use a previously saved configuration, though the installation will be successful, the files will be split between two different installation directories. To avoid this issue, you must reinstall the application using the new templates.

Suppliers

Supplier Organizations and users can now be created with same names. The following limitation exists with duplicate names:

- Users are not able to identify correct supplier or supplier organization on the user interface when only supplier or organization name is displayed.
- All organizations which have duplicate names cannot be invited to events using the Integration Framework.

Workaround

You can invite suppliers for events from the user interface.

Users

Users can be assigned a currency that is not the same as the currency of the organization to which the users belong to.

IF Template Limitations

The following limitations exist for IF templates:

- Users cannot export large number of events (more than 200 events) in XML in a single operation.
- When an RFX that contains a Decimal type of field is exported and a value that contains more than the allowed number of digits after the decimal point is entered, the value is accepted but it cannot be imported back.

Workaround: Use the information in the comment provided for the field to enter the correct number of digits for this field before you import it.

Please use the following suggestions:

- **Unfreeze panes** - If the comment appears at the top of the window or worksheet and the bottom or right half of the comment is cut off, you may have frozen panes. To view the entire comment, on the **Window** menu, click **Unfreeze Panes**.
- **Enlarge the comment box** - Right-click the cell that contains the comment, click **Edit Comment** on the shortcut menu, and then drag the handles until you can see all of the comment text.

Currency Administration

Procedure of Currency Conversions When Exchange Rate Information is Missing

Pulling Catalog Data (Historical Pricing) into an RFX When Exchange Rate Information is Missing

The system uses an implicit exchange rate of 1 to convert the organization/system primary currency value for the product into the RFX currency value in the following situations:

- The currency table does not exist.
- There is no current currency table.
- The currency table exists but the necessary exchange rate has not been defined.

Pushing RFX Data (Award Data) into the Catalog When Exchange Rate Information is Missing (Note: This applies only to organizations with SourceLink enabled.)

The system uses an implicit exchange rate of 1 to convert the RFX currency value for an item to the organization/system primary currency value if the following information is missing:

- The currency table does not exist.
- There is no current currency table.
- The currency table exists but the necessary exchange rate has not been defined.

Reports use an Implicit Rate of 1.00 when Exchange Rate Information is missing.

Import/Export

Settings for Sourcing Desktop Intelligence Report

- To run Sourcing Desktop Intelligence, the security setting in Microsoft Excel must be set to Medium (recommended) or Low.
- Enable Macros if you set the security setting to Medium.
- The user guide for Sourcing Desktop Intelligence is available only in English.

Considerations for RFP reports using the crosstab option (For Excel 2003 only)

When running RFP reports using the crosstab option, users can select a large number of suppliers and run the report in the .XLS format. The report is generated successfully but it may not open in Microsoft Excel 2003.

Reason: Microsoft Excel 2003 supports 256 columns and if the report contains more than 256 columns it cannot be opened in Microsoft Excel 2003.

Workaround:

- Reduce the number of suppliers for the report.
- Select only the required score-types, either raw or weighted.
- Do not include the question/questionnaire details option.
- Include the My Score option.
- Run the report by supplier, questionnaire, or item instead of cross-tabs. Suppliers are displayed as rows in these options.

Offline Bidding template

When users place bids in an offline bidding template that is downloaded from a version prior to 9.0.3, and use this template to import the bids and responses, then though the import job is displayed as 'Done', the responses and bids do not get imported.

Workaround:

Users must download the latest offline bid template and place bids.

RFX

Manual Invitation Limitation

When an RFx, which has manual invitations enabled, is set to Pending Invitation status for subsequent rounds, the RFx is no longer visible to the included supplier until the RFx is set to Pending or Open.

Precaution While Entering URL

Importing an RFx or Line Item attribute with an invalid URL or creating a Text_Single attribute field with an invalid URL does not result in a failure. It is not possible for the system to validate the URL format completely.

Workaround: Verify that a URL is valid before entering it.

Approach for Rounding Bids

System generated bids such as Proxy Bids and bids created by the Take Lead feature use a rounding mechanism based on auction type. To calculate the effective PPU, a Forward Auction rounds up the Ceiling Price and Reverse Auction rounds down the Floor Price. If the PPU equals 1.66666666, for example, then depending on the type of auction, Emptoris Sourcing does the following:

- Forward Auction - Ceiling Price is rounded up to 1.67.
- Reverse Auction - Floor Price is rounded down to 1.66.

Note: When the Minimum Bid Change feature generates a bid, the bid is always rounded up. In the above example, a PPU of 1.66666666 generated with the Minimum Bid Change feature is rounded up to 1.67 for a Reverse Auction.

This chapter provides information on known issues that may be experienced while working on Emptoris Sourcing. The table below lists the issues that are either not fixed or not implemented in this version. A few of them may have workarounds.

Category	ESP-50551	<p>Re-parenting categories could impact item level user defined fields and their usage in bid level formula fields. When a category is re-parented, then the items associated with the category lose the attributes that are linked to the first parent category. The attributes that get inherited from the second parent category also do not contain values.</p> <p>Bid level formula attributes might not function properly if the formula refers to an item field which in fact is a field defined as part of the item's category (or any ancestor).</p>
Category	ESP-50575	If users create categories in the Emptoris Virtual Supply Master with the code name "root category" and assign a parent to the category, the synchronization between Emptoris Strategic Supply Management and Emptoris Sourcing fails.
Category	ESP-50503	If the default and additional languages in which category name and description are translated are different in Emptoris Sourcing and Emptoris Virtual Supply Master then category synchronization does not happen. For synchronization to happen, the default and additional languages should be same and should also be configured in the same order.
Category	ESP-50383	When users search subcategories of a category, the search result displays all the categories in the list even the categories are not the child of the parent category.

Function	Tracking Number / Sales Force Number	Description
Category	ESP-50674	The 'Key word' field of Category cannot be translated in Emptoris Sourcing, whereas it can be translated in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. If 'keyword' is translated in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management, it is displayed in the default language in Emptoris Sourcing.
Currency	ESP-43143	Approval forms in RFP are created with a different currency then the currency that is set for the RFP.
Currency	ESP-50870	The Emptoris Sourcing application does not support all the currencies that are supported by Emptoris Strategic Supply Management. The following currencies are not supported by Emptoris Sourcing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Angola New Kwanza (AOA) • Serbian Dinar (CSD) • Tajikistan, Ruble (TJR)
Formula	ESP-50917	Formula editor does not work in Mozilla Firefox version 15 and 16 due to a regression in the browser software. It works in version 14 and version 17.
Help	ESP-51143	The Emptoris Sourcing help mentions linking and delinking of buyers to categories from the Emptoris Sourcing application ,which is no longer possible. Linking and delinking buyers from categories can now be done from Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.

Function	Tracking Number / Sales Force Number	Description
Organization	ESP-50574	<p>If organizations are created in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management with the same name as that of Emptoris Sourcing system organizations that is, 'emptoris' or 'emptoris_hierarchy', then Emptoris Sourcing and Emptoris Strategic Supply Management synchronization fails.</p> <p>Also, if users created in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management have the login name same, as that of Emptoris Sourcing seeded users, that is 'admin', 'admin2', 'notification', and 'messaging', then Emptoris Sourcing and Emptoris Strategic Supply Management synchronization fails.</p> <p>Workaround:</p> <p>You must not create organizations by the name, 'emptoris' or 'emptoris_hierarchy' in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.</p>
Sourcing Desktop Intelligence	ESP-50741	<p>If multiple supplier organizations are created with the same name with different users assigned to them and used in an event, then the Basic Bid report of the Sourcing Desktop Intelligence displays the bids of suppliers from only one organization. Supplier bids of other organization are not displayed.</p>
Integration	ESP-50704	<p>For an awarded event, during the contract creation process, the approval form creation may fail if the supplier picked up as an external contact is not mastered in Virtual Supply Master. To avoid this, the buyer users will now have to select the external contact while initiating approval in the Emptoris Contract Management application.</p>
Search	ESP-50490	<p>Users with corporate sourcing manager and divisional sourcing manager role can search for categories even when they do not have category permissions. If they click the subcategory link of the searched category, the application displays an error message.</p>

Search	ESP-50431	In the Internet Explorer browser, the pop-up menu is not displayed when users perform a quick search and click the search results.
Supplier	ESP-50248	The Date Established field of a supplier profile, displays the date and the time the organization was created, even when time is not an input value during supplier organization creation in Emptoris Strategic Supply Management.
User Interface	ESP-50233	Number formats modified in the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management do not reflect properly in Emptoris Sourcing.
Integration	ESP-50842	Users cannot access the Emptoris Spend Analysis application when users click on the bookmark configured on the Emptoris Spend Analysis tile on the user portal of Emptoris Sourcing, is deleted from Emptoris Spend Analysis.
Sourcing Desktop Intelligence	ESP-50860	Sourcing Desktop Intelligence export does not work on 64-bit operating systems.
Report	ESP-50600	Buyer Survey reports do not get generated properly when buyer application managers select the valid and draft option types of responses.
Integration	ESP-44060/00151553 & 00206061	The Emptoris Sourcing application displays an error when users try to retrieve contracts for a supplier profile that has more than hundred contracts.
Integration Framework	ESP-43522	If the same table type question is used in two different questionnaires of an RFX, an error occurs when users try to import the offline response template after responding to the questionnaires offline.
Integration Framework	ESP-43199	If a large number of supplier profile information attributes are defined, the task of exporting all supplier profiles may take a long time to complete or may even fail.

Import	ESP-44311	Workbook protection does not work in .xls format but works fine in .xlsx format. The worksheet protection works in both .xls and .xlsx format.
Language	ESP-38925	The search icon does not appear in the Online Help for the Chinese Traditional and Chinese Simplified languages.
Upgrade	ESP-42652 / 00128518	After migrating to the latest version, buyer application managers are not able to view the reverse auction templates, created by content managers in the earlier version of the application.
User Interface	ESP-43524, ESP-43526, ESP-43528, ESP-44623	Certain characters or words if used in the application, throw an error. Error may occur if certain special characters (such as @, , #, %, \, and more) are used in names for Binders or Business Units. Some restricted words, such as <script, <link, <iframe, <a if used in category name may throw error.
Emptoris Strategic Supply Management	CFGS-1283	When you remove the profile of an application on Red Hat Enterprise Linux or Windows machines, the service of the application is not deleted. You must delete it manually.
Emptoris Strategic Supply Management	VSM-870	For some actions of the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management, users encounter the following security warning on the Internet Explorer : Do you want to view only the webpage content that was delivered securely? Users can safely ignore the message.
Emptoris Strategic Supply Management	CFGS-1446	When you start a service on Red Hat Enterprise Linux machines, an error message is displayed. However, the service starts correctly despite the message. You can safely ignore the error message that occurs due to a WebSphere script.

Emptoris Strategic Supply Management	GATE-2746	If you change the landing application for a user using Bulk Upload, then that value is not updated.
Emptoris Strategic Supply Management	GATE-2849	<p>The following issue occurs only in the Mozilla Firefox 16.0.2 browser.</p> <p>After a user is batch uploaded into the Emptoris Strategic Supply Management, if you modify the batch upload file to enable an application for the user and upload the file again, the newly enabled application is not seen as enabled. In the Internet Explorer or Google Chrome browsers, this issue does not occur.</p> <p>Workaround: After uploading the file again for the user, close the Firefox browser, clear the cache, restart the browser, and then access the application. The newly enabled application is visible.</p>
