Today's World: Complex and Costly


- Heterogeneous, distributed data

 - Adapter/plug-in enabling Ascential products to read from and write to WebSphere MQ
 - Adapter/plug-in enabling DataStage TX to integrate with WebSphere Business Integration Message Broker
- Metadata exchange
 - Ascential MetaBroker for DB2 Cube Views
- Shared mainframe access and event infrastructure
 - WebSphere II Classic Federation adapters and Classic Event Publishers re-sold by Ascential



Near Term Priorities – Next 12 Months

Enhance and deliver planned releases

- Deliver IBM Project Serrano and Ascential Hawk releases in 2005 with expanded integration
 - Continue Ascential packaging strategy for Hawk
- Enhance Serrano and Hawk beyond original plans
 - Expand platform synergy and speed deployment with metadata exchange enhancements and out-of-the-box connectors
 - ▶ Extend Hawk national language translation to address the broader global market
 - ▶ Enhance linkage between DataStage TX and WebSphere Business Integration Message Broker
- Leverage existing platform integration
 - ▶ Enhance business intelligence, business transformation, infrastructure rationalization, and master data management synergies



Future Integration and Simplification

- A converged set of tools based on eclipse
 - Unified information integration user experience based on the Mozart framework
 - Common application integration tooling framework for WebSphere Business Integration and DataStage TX
- An integrated metadata discovery, exchange, and management capability
 - A single repository architecture spanning existing IBM Software Group functionality in combination with elements of the Ascential and IBM metadata initiatives
- A harmonized set of connectors
 - For use across WebSphere Information Integrator, WebSphere Business Integration, and Ascential technologies
- A consistent set of transformation services
 - Available for use across integration disciplines merging Ascential and IBM capabilities
