



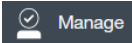


# How to Import the Samples Deployment

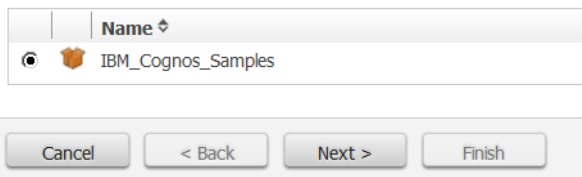
With these instructions, you will learn how to:

1. Copy the deployment file into the correct location
2. Import the deployment into Cognos

Steps:

1. Locate the deployment file called *IBM\_Cognos\_Samples.zip*.
  - a. If you have already installed the samples, it will be under *Samples install location/webcontent/samples/content*.
  - b. If you haven't installed the samples yet, do that first. You can find the instructions [here](#).
2. Copy the deployment file into the deployment folder on the server where IBM Cognos Analytics is installed (*Cognos Analytics install location/deployment*).
3. Launch IBM Cognos Analytics and sign in as an administrator (or any user with sufficient permissions).
4. To import the deployment, click *Manage*  and then  *Administration console*
5. In *IBM Cognos Administration*, click the *Configuration* tab.
6. Click *Content Administration* in the left navigation panel.
7. Click the *New Import*  icon in the toolbar.
8. Select *IBM\_Cognos\_Samples* and click *Next*.



9. On the *Specify a name and description – New Import wizard* page, leave the defaults and click *Next*.
10. On the *Select the public folders, directory and library content – New Import wizard* page, select all the items and click *Next*:



11. On the *Specify the general options – New Import wizard* page, leave the defaults and click *Next*.
12. On the *Review the summary – New Import wizard* page, click *Next*.
13. On the *Select an action – New Import wizard* page, leave the defaults and click *Finish*.
14. On the *Run with options – IBM\_Cognos\_Samples* page, click *Run*.
15. If the confirmation dialog appears, click *OK*.
16. Now there is an IBM Cognos Samples import entry in the content store. Refresh the browser to see the *Samples* folder under *Team Content*:
