In May 2006, the IBM Data Governance Council used poster board and sticky notes in an oak paneled room in the Chateau Frontenac in Quebec City to create the categories, elements, and levels in the first version of the Maturity Model. About 35 people participated in that process in Quebec, and perhaps another 50 more in subsequence meetings.

On September 14-16 2010, the Council will use social networking crowdsourcing technology to include a global community in a discussion about the Maturity Model - Live!

Brainstorming ideas in the room will be transcribed immediately into the topics on infogovcommunity.com. Suggestions and comments from practitioners all around the world will be relayed to the participants in the room.



In 2006, the Council created the Maturity Model as a peer-driven benchmarking tool of member observed behaviors and practices that constitute 11 disciplines of Data Governance with many sub-disciplines and 5 levels of maturity each. A massive collaboration and a burst of creative energy built the original Maturity Model, and many organizations have since benefited by comparing their organizational practices to this peer-driven standard.
