

Additional software for data sources



Additional software is required to crawl the following types of data sources:

IBM DB2 Content Manager

- For Windows or AIX, install IBM DB2 Information Integrator for Content, Version 8.2
- For Linux, install IBM DB2 Content Manager Linux Toolkit, Version 8.2
- Run a setup script provided by IBM WebSphere Information Integrator OmniFind Edition

Collaborative tools

Includes Lotus® Domino® Document Manager (formerly Domino.Doc®), Lotus Notes®, Lotus QuickPlace® (formerly called Team Workplace™)

- Install IBM Lotus Domino Server 6.0.2 CF2 or later
- For AIX, Linux, and Solaris Operating Environment, run **escrnote.sh**; for Windows, run **escrnote.vbs**

Relational databases

Includes DB2 Universal Database for z/OS®, Informix® IDS, Oracle, Sybase, DB2 Universal Database for iSeries™, and Microsoft SQL Server 2000

- Install IBM WebSphere Information Integrator Standard Edition, Version 8.2 or later

Nonrelational mainframe sources

Includes VSAM, IMS™, CA-Datcom, and Software AG Adabas

- Install IBM WebSphere Information Integrator Classic Federation for z/OS
- Install the WebSphere Information Integrator Classic Federation client

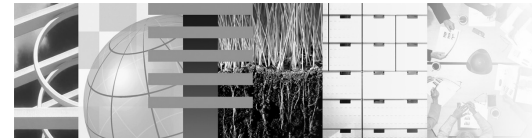

Quick Start Guide: Software Installation



Hardware requirements

- 2 or more processors: 2.0 GHz each for Intel® and AMD, or 1.5 GHz each for RISC
- 4-6 GB RAM, adding 1 GB for each additional active collection
- 320 GB of disk space

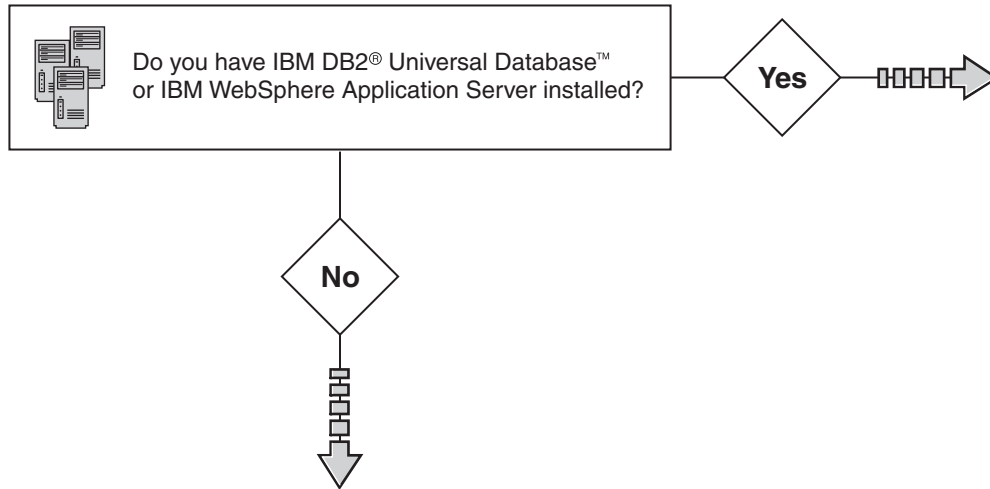

Option 1: Automatic installation for a single server

 If you want to install DB2 Universal Database on a remote server, see "Setting up DB2 Universal Database on a remote server" in *Installation Guide for Enterprise Search*.

1 Start the automatic installation

 Insert the *WebSphere Information Integrator OmniFind Edition, Version 8.3 CD*.

Start the Installation Launchpad. The installation program will check your computer for prerequisite software, including DB2 Universal Database, WebSphere Application Server, and IBM WebSphere Information Integrator Content Edition connectors. Follow the instructions in the installation program until all software is installed.

2 Update WebSphere Application Server

 Insert the *WebSphere Application Server 6.0 Refresh Pack 2*.

Option 2: Manual installation for a single server

Install any software that is not already installed in the following order.

1 Install the database

 If you want to install DB2 Universal Database on a remote server, see "Setting up DB2 Universal Database on a remote server" in *Installation Guide for Enterprise Search*.

 *DB2 Universal Database Enterprise Server Edition, Version 8.2*

2 Install the documentation

 *WebSphere Information Integrator Information Center, Version 8.3*

3 Install the application server

 *WebSphere Application Server, Version 6.0*

Install the WebSphere Application Server base, the WebSphere Application Server plug-in, and the IBM HTTP Server.

4 Update the application server

 *WebSphere Application Server 6.0 Refresh Pack 2*

5 Install enterprise search

 *WebSphere Information Integrator OmniFind Edition, Version 8.3*
