Defining IBM's 'Agile ECM'

Traditional ECM

- Information locked in siloed repository-specific applications
- Unfriendly / difficult / proprietary user experiences
- Many specialized ECM products, little/no integration between them
- ECM investments and solutions limited to the scope of content management
- Lengthy development and deployment cycles


Agile ECM

- Standards-based repositories and services that span multiple application and content types
- Familiar, easy-to-use, attractive experiences for any business user
- Broad but open platform for rapid deployment of shared services
- ECM is tightly coupled with many other IT services to extend the value of content
- Business value identified in days, production apps deployed in weeks

- Built on and integrated with ECM platform with full auditability for chain-of-custody



- Advanced conceptual search and content analytics for rapid case insight








