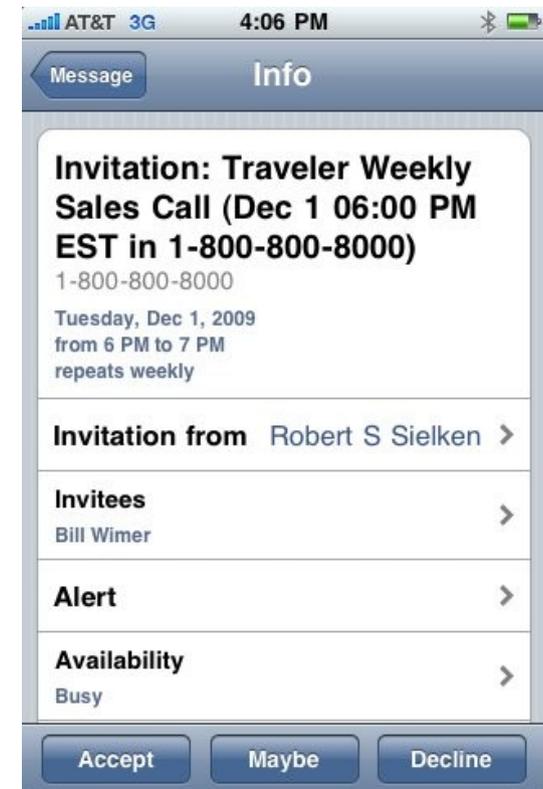
Lotus Notes Traveler Server

- Lotus Notes Traveler runs as a service on the Domino server
- Operating System
 - Windows® 2003/2008 Server (32-bit)
 - Windows 2003/2008 Server for Intel® 64-bit
- Variety of server topologies possible including:
 - Using VPN
 - Reverse proxy
 - Domino server with Lotus Notes Traveler component in the DMZ

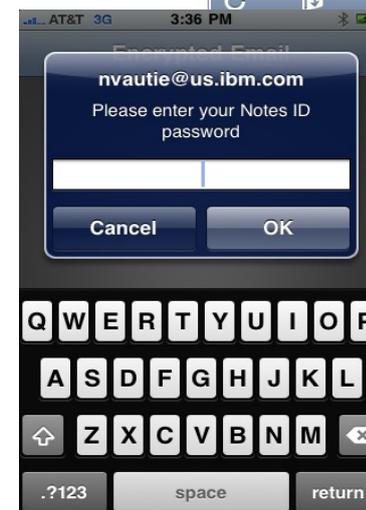
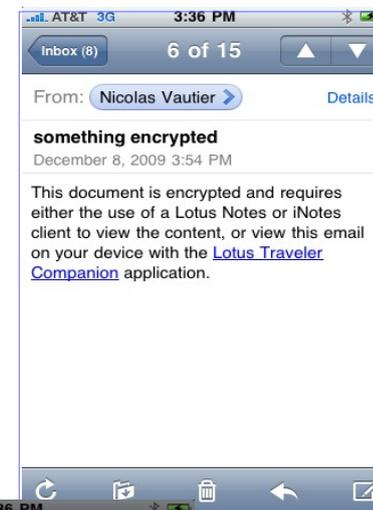
- iPhone invitation support

- Lotus Notes Traveler Server update
 - Included in 8.5.1 Fixpack 1
- Adds Attendee invitation handling on iPhone
 - Accept, Decline, Tentatively Accept



Lotus Notes Traveler Companion

- iPhone application
- Allows user to read Domino-encrypted mail
 - Built on same design as Nokia and Windows Mobile
 - Requires Notes ID to be accessible from Lotus Notes Traveler server (in ID vault or mail file)
 - Uses link inside mail to jump to Companion
 - User supplies Notes ID password
 - Lotus Notes Traveler server does decryption
 - Does not store encrypted mail on the iPhone
- Available for free from iTunes App Store
 - “As is”, unsupported
 - Licensed to end user, not part of enterprise license
 - Requires Lotus Notes Traveler server update
 - Included in 8.5.1 Fixpack 1
