

This module will cover the desktop installation for IBM Rational[®] RequisitePro[®] versions 7.1 and higher.



This presentation will cover two topics. An introduction to RequisitePro V7.1 and steps to perform a desktop installation. When you complete this module you are able to install RequisitePro V7.1 successfully.



RequisitePro versions before V7.1 used a different installer that only installed RequisitePro. Requisite Pro V7.1 now uses Installation Manager which can be used to install multiple packages such as RequisitePro, SoDA[®], ClearQuest[®], and so on. The GUI is different than what you have been used to seeing in the past but each step is outlined for you in the upcoming slides.



This is a screen capture of what the installer looks like before Requisite Pro V7.1.



This is a screen capture of what the installer for RequisitePro V7.1 looks like using Installation Manager.



The next two topics will cover the pre-requisites for the RequisitePro installation and the steps to complete the installation.



This slide points you to the location on the IBM publication center to view the system requirements for RequisitePro V7.1.



Open the directory containing the extracted installation files. Double click launchpad.exe to start the installation.



Click "Install IBM Rational RequisitePro V7.1". You can also view the readme or installation guide by clicking the links under "View Release Information".

Make sure you disable any anti-virus or security software before continuing. This can prevent certain files from being extracted during the installation. The files that it typically prevents are necessary for RequisitePro and RequisiteWeb to function properly.
