WebSphere Lombardi Edition is a business process management (BPM) offering for building and managing process applications. Lombardi has a single comprehensive environment for process design, execution, monitoring, and optimization, and is specifically designed to make it easy for process owners and business users to engage directly in the improvement of their business processes.
