IBM WebSphere Voice Response for Windows



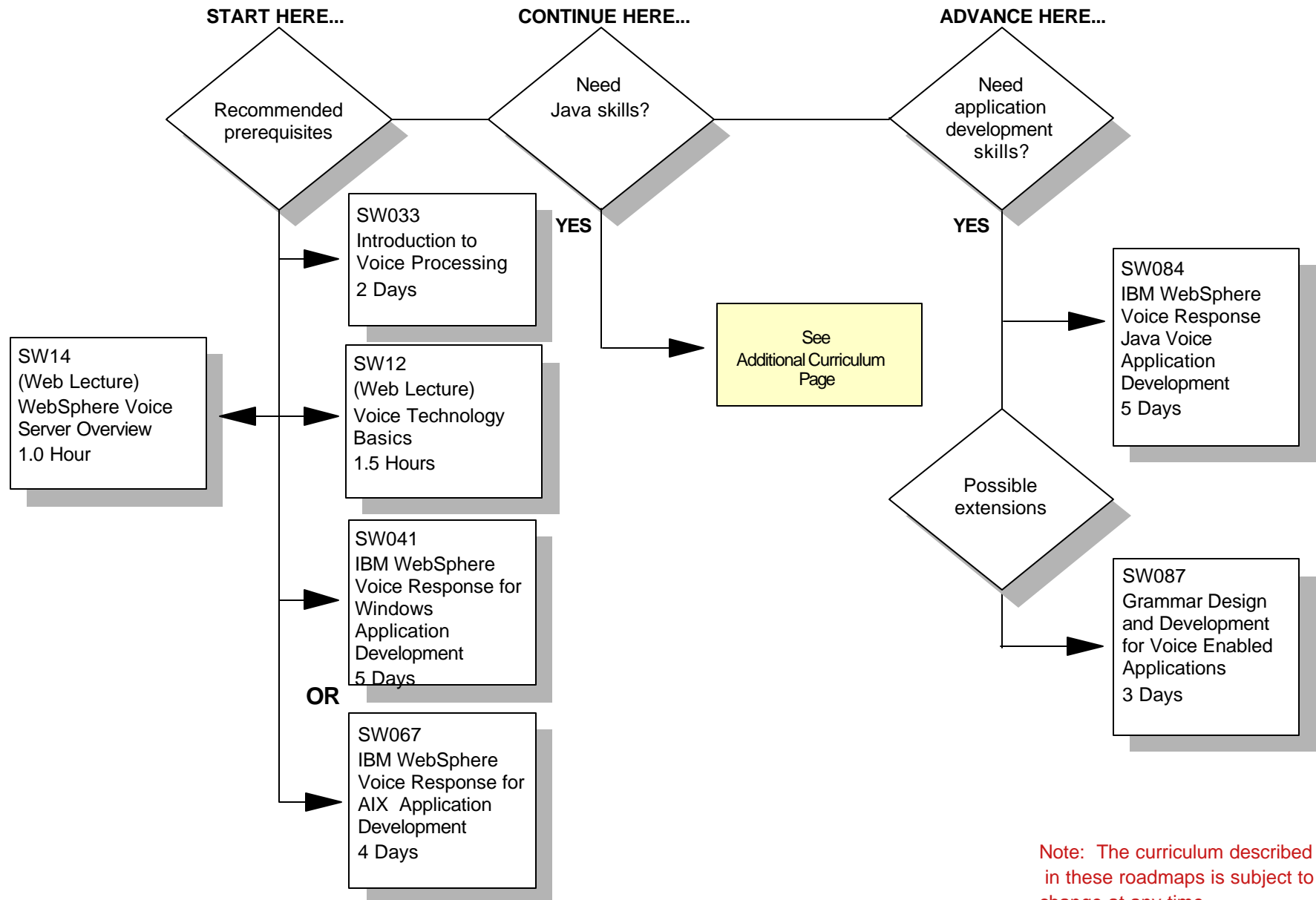
