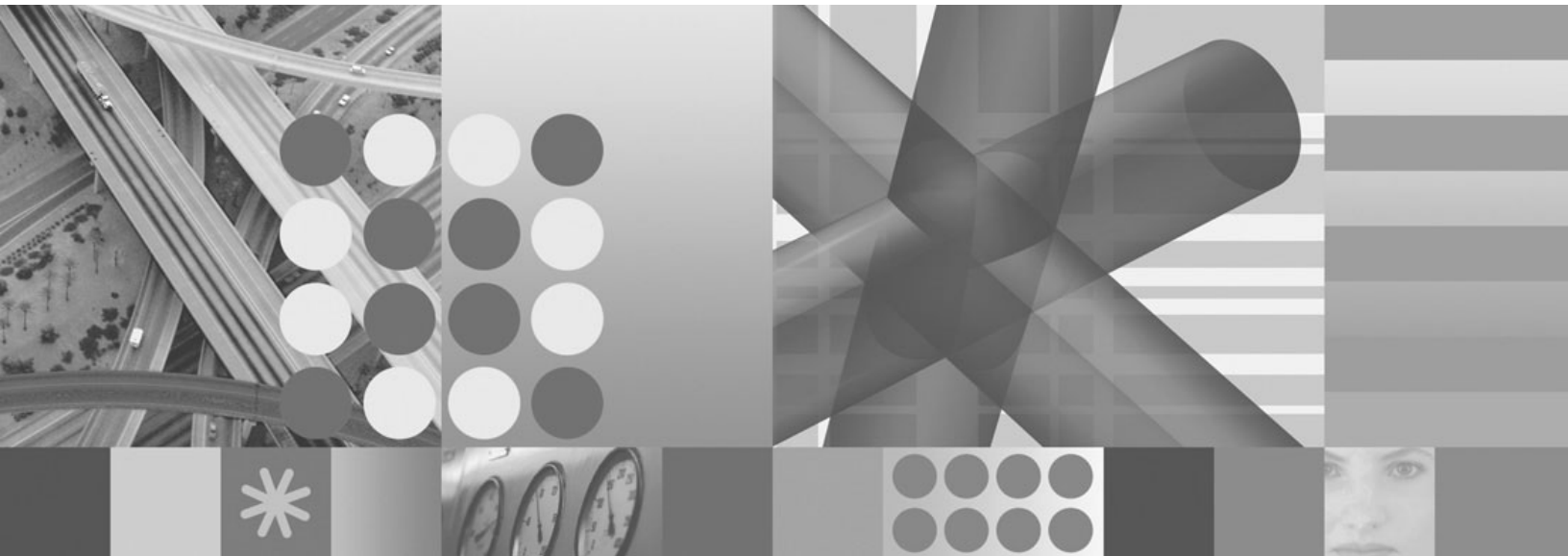

### Config Editor (CE) issues

*Table 1. Config Editor issues*

Component	Issue
Performance logging	If you run an AssemblyLine with performance logging enabled, an exception is thrown and no performance information is logged.
CE Usage	If you add a Case to a Switch in an AssemblyLine, an error occurs when you attempt to edit the Case expression. The Case expression edit box and Editor toolbar disappear and the field becomes read-only.
CE Usage	If your PATH ends with a backslash (\), any attempt to run an AssemblyLine from the CE fails.
CE Usage	Help links for the following topics do not work: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The AssemblyLine <b>Description</b> tab</li><li>• The AssemblyLine <b>Operations</b> tab</li><li>• The <b>Config</b> item in the Config Browser</li><li>• All EventHandler tabs</li></ul>
