

IBM Express and Middleware™ Licensing Guide

IBM Express and Middleware Programs have an array of licensing options to help obtain the correct quantity of software entitlements required for Licensee's environment. Some Programs have licensing terms and conditions which limit the maximum Authorized Use. This guide contains a listing of such Programs which are licensed on Processor Value Unit (PVU), Limited Use Socket (LU Socket), or Limited Use Virtual Server (LU Virtual Server) in either full or sub-capacity environments. If a Program is not listed, refer to the Program's License Information document at <http://www-03.ibm.com/software/sla/slabd.nsf>.

The table below indicates for a given Program the maximum Authorized Use based on the licensing metric.
