#### Quickr Web UI exposes ECM integration to end users

Quickr Web UI talks directly to Quickr server, but provides

ECM integration via end user menu actions

- User initiated document move, move with link, or copy into ECM
- Create links to existing ECM content within Quickr
- Display contents of ECM folders within Quickr easily using feeds
- Search ECM content from within Lotus Quickr



What it looks like Quickr and ECM from Web 2.0





- Extends the reach of the ECM system to the casual user
- Leverages existing ECM repository and assets to a broader audience
- Direct access to both Quickr and ECM systems via Quickr connectors
- Provides Web 2.0 collaboration tools such as team rooms, blogs, wikis, forums, calendaring, tasks lists, etc.
- Extends ECM content into full collaboration and messaging space to include Lotus Connections and Lotus Sametime


