Governance and EA/PMO: A backwards approach?



1. Forget the details. Pure '**top- down**' approach.
2. **Chock Therapy** – give top management overview they did not now they needed or could get. Fast.
3. Tool support **very early** (don't wait for the process to be defined)
4. **Time box** implementation – *weeks, not years*
5. **Benefit Realization first** – not last...
