## 1.2 XCLI Version 2.4

1.2.1 In Session Mode: Use of y'-y', to force a command to execute without warning, may now be used per each command inside XCLI Session mode

# 2 Bug Fixes

#### 2.1 Fixes in Version 2.4.1a

2.1.1 When working with system version 10.1.0.b and above, special characters, such as '@', may now be used for the user login and password [SYS-6519, UI-8756]

## 2.2 Fixes in Version 2.4.1

#### 2.3 Fixes in Version 2.4

#### **Session Mode fixes**

- 2.3.1 Copy/paste is now supported using Ctrl-C and Ctrl-V [UI-2625]
- 2.3.2 XCLI Session now handles fonts properly, avoiding the occasional use of 'garbage' fonts on certain systems [UI-4107]
- 2.3.3 Environment variables for username and password are now respected in XCLI Session mode [UI-2443]

# 3 Known Issues and Limitations in Version 2.4.1a

#### 3.1 General Issues:

3.1.1 Issue: XCLI Session is disconnected when management node changes [UI-4580]
Reason: XCLI is currently unable to failover to the next management IP when necessary
Corrective Action: Launch XCLI session again

#### 3.2 XCLI Native Mode Issues:

3.2.1 **Issue:** In Windows, XCLI scripts must be provided with full path [UI-2455]

**Reason:** When using xcli -r <script> the script file cannot be interpreted based on the relative path

Corrective Action: Always provide the script file full path

#### 3.3 XCLI Session Mode Issues:

- 3.3.1 Issue: Typing '&' in XCLI Session mode breaks the session and exits [UI-5341] Corrective Action: None. This will be fixed in the coming release of XCLI
- 3.3.2 Issue: In non-English Windows, XCLI may fails to accept certain characters correctly [UI-2456]

Corrective Action: None. This will be fixed in the coming release of XCLI
